
Dear Chairman Tenenbaum,

Thank you for taking the time to meet with me on December 7, 2011, to discuss the important issue of contaminated Chinese drywall. Please know that I appreciate your work on this issue.

As I expressed in the meeting, it is my belief that all relevant agencies of the United States government should be working toward bringing the responsible parties to justice. Like you, I am frustrated at the lack of responsiveness on the part of your Chinese counterparts. There is no question that all companies responsible for this defective product should be held accountable. It is my request that the Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) continue to make this a priority during direct discussions and visits with Chinese officials.
