

Water Resources Development Act (WRDA) of 2010

Congressman Bachus submitted the following requests for the Water Resources Development Act (WRDA) of 2010 on December 3, 2009. Requests are subject to review by the House Transportation and Infrastructure Committee and are being provided in the spirit of full disclosure.

Project: Water and Sewer System Infrastructure Improvements, Montevallo

Amount Requested: \$10,000,000

Proposed Recipient: City of Montevallo

Explanation of Request:

Repair and update water system distribution lines and sewer collection pipes for City of Montevallo water system. Provide needed upgrades to water distribution pipes that are more than twenty years old to ensure the highest water quality standards and modernize sewer collection pipes to eliminate infiltration and enhance lift station ability to keep up with flows.

Project: Construction of new wastewater treatment plant, Jemison

Amount Requested: \$5,000,000

Proposed Recipient: City of Jemison

Explanation of Request:

Construction of new wastewater treatment plant in Jemison to meet needs related to city's increased growth and development and ability to meet more stringent discharge limits. Plant will be a 400,000 gallon per day (GPD) average and 1.2 M peak treatment facility expandable to 1.6 MGD and 4.8 MGD peak.
