. Bachus served a six-year leadership term as Committee Chairman (2011-2012) and Ranking Member from (2007-2010). The Financial Services Committee deals with issues of everyday concern to Alabamians such as investor protection, the soundness of the banking system, financial regulation, housing policy, trade and monetary policy, and helping our financial markets function for the benefit of individuals who need credit and businesses that need capital to expand and create jobs. As Chairman, Congressman Bachus is an ex officio member of all subcommittees and a voting member on the Capital Markets and Government Sponsored Enterprises Subcommittee and the Financial Institutions and Consumer Credit Subcommittee.

Congressman Bachus has rejoined the Judiciary Committee as Chairman of the Subcommittee on Regulatory Reform, Commercial, and Antitrust Law. He also serves on the Subcommittee on Crime, Terrorism, Homeland Security, and Investigations. The Judiciary Committee is the second oldest standing committee in the House. Each of its subcommittees has roots in the U.S. Constitution.
