

WASHINGTON – Congressman Spencer Bachus today joined Congressmen Joe Wilson (SC), Eric Cantor (VA) and Congresswoman Marsha Blackburn (TN) in a press conference urging the “Blue Dog” Democrats to practice what they preach regarding deficit reduction.
