

WASHINGTON-Congressman Spencer Bachus voted in favor of the bill that passed the House today by a 281-142 vote overwhelmingly approving the final version of legislation banning partial-birth abortion. “It’s time we put an end to this inhumane and gruesome practice”, Bachus said.

The Senate is expected to pass the bill, and it would be sent to the President for his approval.

An abortionist who violates this ban would be subject to fines, a maximum of two years imprisonment, or both. This ban includes an exception for those situations in which a partial-birth abortion is deemed necessary to save the life of the mother.
