

Congressman Bachus spearheaded a letter to Senate Majority Leader Harry Reid and Republican Leader Mitch McConnell objecting to the inclusion of language legalizing internet gambling in a tax bill or any other measure brought up in front of Congress during the 2010 lame duck session. Bachus is the author of the Unlawful Internet Gambling Enforcement Act (UIGEA) of 2006, which prohibits the use of credit cards and other financial instruments from being used for illegal internet gaming.
