

WASHINGTON (September 14) – A federal regulation that Congressman Spencer Bachus (AL-6) said could force the demolition of emergency storm shelters built to protect school children in Alabama has attracted national attention.

The Fox News Channel today quoted Congressman Bachus in a report on a Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) rule that could result in taxpayer money being used to tear down newly-built storm shelters.

Congressman Bachus is planning to legislate to prevent FEMA from demolishing the shelters.
